ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON CURRICULUM FEEDBACK OBTAINED FROM STUDENTS

The College considers the curriculum as the heart of education and IQAC collects regular feedback on curriculum from various stake holders; students, teachers etc. The collected feedback is then analyzed and the report is submitted to the Department Head. However, IQAC intimates the feedback reports to the members of the concerned Committee. They in turn bring the matter to the notice of the University. Most of the concerns are addressed in the revised syllabus. The feedback form consists of items specific to the students and there are statements which are rated on a 4-point rating scale (strongly agree, agree, neither agree nor disagree, disagree) and one item is qualitative in nature for their open comments. Feedback is taken anonymously from the students.

Confidentiality is maintained. In case of Students' feedback, a few students from across the department are randomly selected to avoid any kind of biasness.

Most of the students are of good opinion on curriculum design and development. A very few students have expressed their dissatisfaction over some questions. Based on these opinions the following action has been taken.


