

NCC NAVAL WING REPORT 2019-2020

16th July 1948 was the red day for the youth of India because on this day NCC in India came into existence and the naval wing was later added in 1952. In our college NCC Naval wing came into existence in 1965.

NCC focuses on moulding the Youth of the country into trained citizens, It develops qualities like Leadership, commandership, discipline, Punctuality etc among the cadets. It motivates the youth to join the armed forces of our country. In 1962 and 1965 wars NCC cadets were the 2nd line of Defence. They provided many services to the soldiers fighting in the front. They also worked hand in hand with the civil authorities for the rescue and welfare of Civilians during war time.

The training year 2019-2020 began with the enrollment of cadets on 7th July 2019 under the support and guidance of our Associate NCC Officer Lt. Shivkumar PT. There were 50 cadets in the wing who actively took part in the activities conducted in the training year, and ranks were issued on the basis of the performance of cadets in all the events. Cdt Soujanya Acharya was promoted to senior cadet captain of 6 KAR NAVAL UNIT, UDUPI and Cdt. Amulya Shetty was promoted to cadet captain of 4/6 KAR NU NCC, PPC, UDUPI for the training year 2019-2020.

We conducted many Social welfare programs during the year and they are as follows:

In the month of August our proud cadets— provided their humble assistance to overcome disaster situation of flood occurred in Chikmagalur by donating food, cloth materials and other basic needs.

Kargil Vijay Diwas held at our college— on 26th July 2019, on the same day we participated in tree plantation held at Manipal.

We conducted Swachh Bharath Abhiyan at Kunjarugiri temple and near by areas on 20th August 2019 in which 25 cadets of our wing participated.

On 12th Dec we visited various colleges and gave lecture on the topic personal Health and Hygiene and motivated them to join Indian armed forces and gave information about NCC navy as well as Indian Navy in depth.

25 cadets from our Naval wing participated in beach cleaning at Malpe and park cleaning at Ajjarkad on 26th Dec 2019.
