NSS ANNUAL REPORT: 2018-19

The enrolment of students for National Service Scheme for the academic year was completed in the month of June and regular activities were conducted there upon.

At present NSS has a strength of 203 volunteers. There are two NSS units rendering their service in Poornaprajna College, Udupi. There are 123 volunteers in unit-I and 80 volunteers in unit-II.
