#### **BRIEF HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE**

Poornaprajna College, popularly known as PPC, is situated in a vast green campus at the heart of Udupi city. Poornaprajna College is one of the educational institutions run by Udupi Shree Adamaru Matha Education Council, Bengaluru. Poornaprajna College was founded in 1960 by the Swamijis of eight Mathas of Udupi. But, in February 1962, with a view to streamline the day-to-day working of the institution, its maintenance and governance were handed over to Adamaru Matha Education Council, a registered society functioning under the leadership of H. H. Sri Sri Vibudhesha Theertha Swamiji of Adamaru Matha. Now, the Council is functioning under the leadership of H. H. Sri Sri Eeshwapriya Theertha Swamiji of Sri Adamaru Matha.

Initially, the College offered courses in Commerce and Humanities streams. In 1963 science subjects were introduced in pre-university level. Two years later science stream was started at the degree level. In 1975 Management studies were introduced at the degree level. In 2001, the pre-university courses were detached from the college and transferred to the newly established Poornaprajna Unaided Pre-University College. In 2006 Poornaprajna Institute of Management (MBA College) sprouted from Poornaprajna College. In 2016 PG courses M.Com and M.Sc. in Mathematics were started.

In its early days, the College had the privilege of having eminent scholars and writers like Prof. V.M. Inamdar, Dr. Shankar Mokasi Punekar, Prof. Gopalakrishna Adiga and Dr. P. Narayana Rao as its Principals. After these titans, the tradition was continued by able administrators such as Prof. K.G. Tantry, Prof. Sripathi Upadhya, Prof. H. Shivarama Shetty, Prof. Sudhakar Rao, Prof. M. Subrahmanya, Prof. N. B. Dixit, Dr. S. L. Karnik, Prof. A. K. Halapet, Dr. N.A. Madyastha, Prof. S. Subhashchandra and Prof. Rajmohan, Prof.K.Sadashiva Rao, Dr B. Jagadeesh Shetty, Dr. A.P. Bhat. Presently Dr. Raghavendra A, Presented by Dr. Ramu L. is heading the institution.

The year 2009-10 was celebrated as the Diamond Jubilee Year. The college has been conferred the "Award of Excellence" by Udupi Chamber of Commerce & Industry for being the best college in Udupi district in the category of "Advanced Education" for the year 2011.

In September 2022, College was re-accredited by NAAC with 'A+' grade (3.27 CGPA) for a further period of 5 years.

The college has witnessed eminent personalities like Bharatha Ratna Prof. C. N. R. Rao, Padmavibhusan Prof. U. R. Rao, Veteran Kannada Actor, Padmabhushan Dr. Rajkumar during various occasions.

### **DISCIPLINE: NORMS AND REGULATIONS**

With regard to building an ideal academic atmosphere in the college premises, students are required to abide by the following regulations. Students should abide by the college regulations set forth in the calendar as well as those formulated from time to time by the Principal. Cases of non-compliance shall be dealt with suitably.

- At the first bell, (5 minutes before the hour fixed for each session) students are expected to enter the class and occupy their places. At the second bell the lecturers will enter the classes and students stand in respectful silence to receive them and after that students are not allowed to enter the classroom.
- During the first hour in the morning after the second bell students should stand for prayer. After the prayer there will be breathing exercises.
- They should be punctual and regular in attending the classes.
- They should wear uniforms all the days when they visit the college for any work.
- If any student has to leave the premises during class hours, he/she should get permission from the Principal, and should duly record his/her name, roll number, class and time of exit in the register maintained by security guard at the gate.
- Further, every student should record his/her absence/leave in the calendar (in the pages provided for that purpose) and get it signed by the parent/guardian and teacher concerned.
- If the lecturer concerned is absent, students shall not loiter in the campus. They are expected to be in the library or indoor stadium.
- Students are advised to maintain their classroom neat & clean and create environmental awareness by keeping the campus clean and plastic free. It is requested to switch off the electrical devices while vacating class rooms.
- Wilful damage to the college property shall attract heavy penalty and offenders shall be required to repair/replace the property.
- Boys and girls are expected to conduct themselves with dignity and respect. Students should maintain a high standard of decency and decorum both within and outside the campus.

- No student shall be an active member of any club, association, union, or organization unconnected with the college or of any sevadal, sena, or sevaka sangha or any particular party whatsoever, without the written consent of the Principal.
- No student shall participate in any campaign, demonstration, agitation, hartal, satyagraha or strike directed against the college, the University, or the Government. In the case of violation of this directive, serious penal action will be taken.
- No students shall play for any team other than the college once without the written consent of the Principal.
- No excursion related to study requirements shall be conducted by the college.
- Bursting crackers within the college is a serious offense. Under no circumstances crackers are permitted inside the premises.
- Setting on window sill, loitering in the corridors and crowding at the doors are strictly prohibited. Violation of this directive shall attract a penalty.
- Books, magazines, newspapers etc., not approved by the College authorities are not allowed to be brought to the College.
- Students should not bring Mobile phones to the campus. Students are not permitted to use mobile phones, smart watches, or any bluetooth devices on the College campus. If they are found, the cell will be confiscated and will be returned at the end of the academic year. Students are not supposed to play or listen to music using any electronic devices on the College campus.
- Indifference to studies, non-submission of practical records and assignments in time, avoidance of tests and examinations conducted by the college and discourtesy to establishment are strictly discouraged. These infringements might attract penal action if any student is persistent on such irregularities.
- Coming to college in an intoxicated state, smoking within the college premises, using obscene and vulgar words against others, disrespect to teacher, indulging in malpractice during examinations and moral delinquency are serious offenses and the penalty for

those could be severe to the extent of expulsion from the college.

- Outstation students living in PG/rented houses/flats should invariably furnish the details of the place of residence, in the application.
- Students of Poornaprajna College cannot form or join any groups on social media platforms in connection with the college affairs without the prior permission of the Principal. You are also advised not to publish any writing / oral material on any other groups or platforms without the permission of the Principal. Such writing / groups will be legally dealt by the Principal and Management of the Institute.
- Students are not authorized to collect donations from the public for any of the College activities without the permission of the Principal.
- Students are not permitted to celebrate/organize any religious festival within the College campus without the prior permission of the Principal.
- While recommending the student for scholarship, Attendance, academic progress and conduct of the student is considered for the merit.

### RAGGING IS PUNISHABLE

As per the orders of the Honourable Supreme Court of India, if any case of ragging comes to the notice of the authorities, the concerned student shall be given an opportunity of being heard, and if found guilty, would be expelled from the institution.

No cases of ragging have been reported in the institution in the past years. However, as a preventive measure, a Ragging Prevention Cell with following members has been constituted.

### REGULATIONS REGARDING ATTENDANCE

- 1. A student who is not present in the concerned lecture hall at the begining of each period will be marked absent for the period.
- 2. If owing to illness or other unforeseen circumstances, a student is unable to apply for leave in advance, he must obtain leave retrospectively and this he must do on the day of his return to the College. He shall produce a medical certificate issued by a competent authority preferably as Asst. Surgeon of the Govt. Hospital.
- 3. The Mangalore University insists that a student should attend at least 75% of the lectures and of the practicals in each subject.
- 4. The condonation is not permitted as per University rules.
- 5. Students attending special NCC or NSS camps or Cocurricular activities during working days should inform the Principal in advance to claim attendance later on this ground. Even here, a claim can be made only if it is supported by the documentary evidence. A student cannot claim attendance based on filmsy reasons (picnic, function at home, excursion, voluntary work etc.)
- 6. If the attendance is below 75% in any one subject, he/she shall not be permitted to appear for examination.

### REGULATIONS REGARDING EXAMINATIONS / TESTS

1. The college will hold periodical examinations and tests to assess the students' progress and also their applications to studies. The marks obtained in these examinations will be considered for Internal Assessments.

- 2. If a student absents himself for valid reasons for the internal assessment test, the student should inform the Principal immediately through a letter with valid documents. Such students may be permitted to appear for re-examination.
- 3. During internal tests, after the first bell (which will be 15 minutes before commencement of test) students are expected to enter the exam hall and occupy the place allotted. In the second bell (which will be 5 minutes before the commencement of test) room invigilators are expected to enter the hall. Students are not allowed to enter the exam hall after the second bell, without the room invigilator's permission.
- 4. If a student, who is selected for the award of any scholarship/loan scholarship/freeships/ fee concession, stays aways for the college examination / test. He will be liable to forfeiture of such as aid.

### Laboratory regulations

- 1. No student shall enter any of the College Laboratories without the permission of the Lecturer who is in-charge.
- 2. The Students who have practicals to do should be at their places in the laboratories at least five minutes before the commencement of the practical sessions.
- 3. Before beginning the experiments they should carefully check up the materials given to them.
- 4. They should handle the equipment and materials given to them for their practical work with care. They shall pay for the damage suffered to the equipment at their hands.
- 5. They should maintain silence in the laboratories during practical work. No student leave the practical hall without the

- permission of the Teacher-in-charge.
- 6. When their practical work is over for the day, they should again check up the equipment and the materials given to them and hand them over to the persons who are in-charge.
- 7. Students who have been provided with lockers in the laboratories shall be responsible for the safe custody of the materials assigned to them.
- 8. All science students should provide themselves with the requisite Observation Note Books and Record Books. They must maintain regularly their records of practical work and submit them as required, to the teachers concerned.

### Library Rules and regulations

- 1. An Identity card is a must for all library transactions.
- 2. Borrower's Cards are not transferable. The Borrower is responsible for the books borrowed on his/her card.
- 3. Users are requested to maintain strict silence in the library.
- 4. Use of smart phone/mobile phone is strictly prohibited
- 5. Users should fully cooperate with the library staff.
- 6. Books borrowed should be returned on or before the due date. Rs. 1/- per day of fine will be charged for the delay in return.
- 7. If the books are lost, then the borrower shall replace the book of same edition; or pay two times the cost of the book.
- 8. Loss of borrower's card should be reported to the librarian. Duplication borrower's card may be issued against formal application and fees.
- 9. Any kind of refreshment shall not be taken in the library premises.

### **General Rules**

- 1. Students are free to play after working hours on all working days.
- 2. The Physical Director of the College nominates the captains of the various teams.
- 3. When representative teams are formed, players for the teams will be selected by the Physical Director from among the students who play regularly and attend coaching classes and intramural competitions.
- 4. When competitions are organized by the College only those who carry out the directions of the Physical Director and who are regular for practice, will be allowed to compete. Players whose record is excellent in the College will be permitted to participate in tournaments.
- 5. Students who receive games and sports materials should return them safely to the person who has issued them.
- 6. Students who are on the rolls of this College are not permitted to represents any outside team in any event against the College.

### **FACILITIES**

### **Eco Friendly College Campus**

College has been making a conscious effort to maintain its campus green, clean and eco-friendly. Several steps have been initiated in this regard.

- 1. **Vermi-Bin:** All the bio-degradable waste, and dry leaves collected in the campus are converted into organic compost.
- **2. Rain Water Harvesting:** The campus buildings are designed to store and reuse the rain water in the underground tanks.
- **3. Pipe composting:** Wet wastes are collected from the hostel and converted into compost by pipe compost method.
- **4. Green Audit:** Campus is green audited by the ISO certified auditor. All the plants and trees are named with QR code.
- **5. Pedestrian friendly campus:** Vehicles are only allowed up to the parking area and barriers are installed to avoid the vehicles.

### Co-curricular and Extra-curricular Activities

College firmly believes that Co-curricular and Extracurricular activities are important to the students for overall development. Inculcation of values, sensitization of social issues, learning to relate to and to deal with others, exercise of participative leadership etc., takes place through co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. The College provides each student to participate in extra-curricular activities through the various organizations and cells.

### SOFT SKILLS/LIFE SKILLS TRAINING PROGRAM

Soft skills /Life skills training program will be provided to the students to prepare them for life and for jobs. Student training cell and Career guidance cell organize the number of treating programs in order for students to succeed in campus recruitment.

### LABORATORIES

There are well-equipped and spacious laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology and Computer Science. Botany and Zoology labs have considerable specimen collection in their museums. There are full-fledged research laboratories attached to Physics, Botany and Zoology departments.

### POORNAPRAJNA ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM

Poornaprajna Archaeological Museum which houses rare collections and antiques, has been established in February 2011. Sri Mahesh Shetty, H.O.D. of History is the co-ordinator.

### AUDIO-VISUAL SECTION

The college has an air-conditioned audio-visual hall (with 80 seats) for projection of educational films, slides and audio input. There is a vast collection of educational cassettes and CDs. Students have full access to facilities available in this section. This section is headed by Si Athul Bhat, an expert in electronics.

### PHYSICAL EDUCATION DEPARTMENT

The college has a spacious playground named after Late Bailoor Krishna Rao within the premises of the college walls where outdoor games like basketball, volley ball, shuttle badminton etc. are played. The ground also has tracks and pits for athletic events. The Physical Education Department is maintained by the Physical Education Director. The 'H.H. Sri Vibudhesha Theertha Swamiji Poornaprajna Indoor Stadium' which was built in 2009-10 to commemorate golden jubilee celebrations, houses a shuttle badminton court and a gymnasium.

### N.C.C.

The college has two N.C.C. units, namely, SD Army Wing, commanded by Dr. Major Prakash Rao A. and SD Naval Wing, commanded by Mr. Anand Rayamane. These units provide opportunity for weapon training, adventure training, special campus, trekking, mountaineering, boat pulling, water sports such as sailing and wind surfing.

### N.S.S.

There are two N.S.S. Units in the college officered by Mr. Sandeep and Ms. Suparna. The intake is 200 and it is open to both men and women students of the college. Programs organised by the unit include community service, adult literacy drive, environmental awareness, tree plantation and public health. The unit holds weekend camps in addition to annual special 7 days camp where students work on projects involving manual service. These camps also provide opportunities for developing their talents and thus contribute to their personality development.

### STUDENTS' COUNCIL

- 5. The Principal will preside over all the meetings of the Council.
- 6. The Principal or the Student Welfare Officer will supervise the working of the Council.
- 7. The Council shall neither be used by the students of the College for making any demands with the College Management or the Principal or the College Staff nor for organizing any protest, demonstration or campaign directed against either the College Management, or the Principal, or the Staff or the University or the Government.
- 8. Any representation which the students of the College wish to make to the Principal, whether in regard to the provision of

amenities and facilities in the college, or the organization of the teaching programme or the ordering of the examination programme or any other matter, it must be made independently of the Council. It can be made by any student or group of students.

9. When the council is sought to be used by its members for other purposes it shall be deemed to be ipso facto dissolved.

### FAQ on National Education Policy - 2020

• How many years is the degree?

Degree is of THREE years as earlier. However, the student can continue studying the fourth year degree for which 'Honors Degree' will be awarded.

- What courses are to be studied by the student under NEP? The student can study:
  - \* 2 discipline core papers, one open elective,
  - \* Mandatory papers spread across the degree:
  - \* Ability enhancement courses (Environmental Science, Indian Constitution)
  - \* Skill enhancement courses (Digital Fluency, Artificial Intelligence, Critical thinking, Problem solving, professional communication, Cyber security, Cultural awareness)
  - \* Value based courses (Health and Wellness/Social emotional learning, Sports, NCC, NSS, Ethics and self-awareness)
- What is the structure of a degree course under NEP?
   Under NEP 2020, you can study 2 Discipline core papers in the first three years of degree along with one Open Elective. If you continue studying for the 4<sup>th</sup> year and complete the study, then 'Honors Degree' in the subject will be awarded.
- What is Discipline Core?
   It is the subject to be studied as a major paper. Under NEP, you shall choose TWO Core papers in the first two years. For example: in B.Sc. You can choose Physics and Chemistry as core papers. In the fourth year, if continued, you will study one Discipline core of your choice in particular.
- What are Open Electives (OEs)? Is there any restriction on choosing the OEs?
  - Open Elective is a paper to be studied along with discipline core papers. An open elective paper can be selected from any discipline. Exp: if you study Physics and Chemistry as core papers, then you may select financial management (commerce paper) as an open elective. In the first four semesters, you may choose different OEs from different disciplines.
- In the third year, you need to study the discipline elective (offered by discipline) rather than open elective.

• What is a multiple entry-exit system?

If a student discontinues the study, certification for each completed academic year will be awarded. However, the student can continue the remaining years of study without re-studying the previous years that are already being completed.

• What about certification for each completed academic year?

A student can obtain different certificates for each completed academic year in a degree. For instance, completion of one complete academic year gives eligibility for 'Certificate', two completed academic years gives eligibility for 'Diploma' certificate, three completed academic years gives eligibility for 'Bachelor' degree, and four completed academic years gives eligibility for 'Honors' degree.

• What is an Academic Bank of Credit?

Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) is a virtual/digital storehouse (like digilocker) that contains information on the credits earned by students throughout their learning journey.

• By imparting multidisciplinary education, in which course a student gets a degree?

The degree certificate is awarded in the degree (discipline) chosen by the student. If you chose B.Sc., the degree will be awarded as 'Degree in Bachelor of Science'
